GOA TRANSPORT AGGREGATOR GUIDELINES, 2025

Whereas, Section 67 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 provides for the power of the state Government to control road transport.

And whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred under the said section, the Government of Goa, in public interest, has formulated the following guidelines to regulate aggregators in the state of Goa in supersession of Order No. D.Tpt/STA/2357/2019/1106 dated 06-03-2019.

Now therefore, the following guidelines are hereby published for the information of the persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said guidelines will be taken into consideration by the Government on the expiry of thirty days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

Any objection to the said guidelines may be sent to Director of Transport, 1st Floor, Junta House, Panaji, Goa-403001, before the expiry of the said period of thirty days from the date of publication of this Notification in the Official Gazette.

1. *Short title, extent and commencement.*

- (a) These guidelines shall be called the Goa Transport Aggregator Guidelines, 2025.

(b) They shall extend to the whole of the state of Goa.

(c) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Definitions.

In these guidelines, unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) “Aggregator” means as defined in Section 2(1A) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (b) “App” means an electronic interface operated by the Aggregator or any third party on behalf of the Aggregator, which may be accessed through a computer resource or a communication device.
- (c) “Driver” shall have the meaning ascribed to it under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (d) “Fare” means the charges per kilometre as specified in Schedule-I herein.
- (e) “Government” means the Government of Goa.
- (f) “On-boarding” means the integration of a vehicle and Driver with the Aggregator and operating such vehicle with the Aggregator.
- (g) “Owner” shall have the meaning ascribed to it under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (h) “Passenger” means a person who books a journey through the Aggregator App for availing the transportation provided by a Driver who is On-boarded with the Aggregator.
- (i) “PSV Badge” means an authorisation issued in accordance with Rule 4 of the Goa Motor Vehicles Rules, 1991.
- (j) “Permit” means the contract carriage permit issued to a transport vehicle as per the provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (k) “Tariff” means the charges paid by the Passenger for a journey booked on an Aggregator App.

The words and expressions used in these Guidelines, but not defined herein, shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, or the rules made thereunder.

3. Application for licence.

- (a) No Aggregator shall operate or On-board Drivers in the state of Goa without obtaining a valid licence from the Government under these Guidelines.
- (b) The Aggregator(s) holding an existing licence at the time of these Guidelines coming into force, shall continue to operate until the expiry of the existing licence.

Provided that such operations shall be in compliance with these Guidelines.

- (c) Any person may make an application for grant of licence in Form-I appended to these Guidelines, accompanied by proof of payment of appropriate fee and security deposit as specified in sub-clause (13).

- (d) A licence shall be granted by the Government and such licence shall be valid throughout the state of Goa.
- (e) An application under sub-clause (3) above shall be processed by the Government within a maximum period of sixty (60) working days from the date of application.
- (f) A licence granted shall be valid for a period of three (03) years from the date of its issuance, subsequent to which it shall be renewable for period(s) of three (03) years.
- (g) An Aggregator may make an application for grant of renewal in Form-II appended to these Guidelines, accompanied by proof of payment of appropriate Fee, as specified in sub-clause (13), not less than six (06) months prior to the expiry of their licence.
- (h) The list of licences issued by the Government under these Guidelines shall be published on the state transport department website.
- (i) The Government may reject an application for grant of licence or renewal, if any of the conditions specified under these Guidelines are not complied with to the satisfaction of the Government.
- Provided that no such rejection shall be made without giving the applicant or Aggregator an opportunity of being heard and for reasons recorded in writing.
- (j) The Government shall issue a licence in Form-III appended to these Guidelines.
- (k) A licence issued under these Guidelines is non-transferable.
- (l) Where the licence is lost or destroyed, an Aggregator may make an application for grant of duplicate licence in Form-IV appended to these Guidelines, accompanied by proof of payment of appropriate Fee as specified in sub-clause (13).

(m) Fee and Security Deposit for Aggregator:

4. Conditions for licence.

The Aggregator shall:

- (a) Have a registered office in the state of Goa (or) have a registered office in India, and a branch office in the state of Goa.

- (b) Comply with all applicable laws, including the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, Consumer Protection Act, 2019 and the Information Technology Act, 2000.
- (c) Commence their business operations within six (06) months from the grant of the licence, in the absence of which the licence may be liable to be cancelled by the Government.
- (d) Store data recorded during provision of services in the state of Goa, in servers located in India, and retain such data for not less than three (03) years.
- (e) On-board only Driver(s) with a valid PSV Badge.
- (f) Execute a valid enforceable contract with the Driver, with jurisdiction for dispute resolution in the state of Goa.
- (g) Not prevent or disincentivise the driver to On-board with multiple Aggregators.
- (h) Ensure a health insurance for an amount not less than Ten Lakh Rupees (INR 10,00,000) with Financial Year 2025-26 as base year and an increment of 5% each year.

Provided that in case of female Drivers, the health insurance shall be extended to the parents and children of the female Driver.

- (i) On-board only a vehicle with valid permit issued by State Transport Authority or Regional Transport Authority in the state of Goa as per the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.
- (j) Display inside the vehicle the copy of Driver's licence and the vehicle permit in such manner as shall be clearly visible to the Passenger(s).
- (k) Ensure that the identity of the Driver undertaking a trip is the same as the one provided to the Passenger on the App at the time of booking.

5. Regulation of Fare and Tariff.

- (a) The Aggregator shall guarantee that the Owner receives at least the Fare as prescribed by the Government, for every journey completed by the Passenger.
- (b) The Aggregator shall not make any deductions whatsoever from the Fare receivable by the Owner as prescribed in sub-clause (1) above.
- (c) The Aggregator shall ensure that all the payments to the Owner are settled within seventy two (72) hours from the completion of the journey.
- (d) In case of failure to settle the payment as prescribed in sub-clause (3) above, the Aggregator shall be liable to pay a penal interest of twenty five percent (25%) per day to the Owner on the delayed payments.
- (e) The Passenger shall be charged Tariff for a minimum of three (3) kilometres for every journey booked on the Aggregator App.

6. *Incentives.*

(a) The Government shall provide the following incentives to the Owners On-boarded on any Aggregator App.

7. *Grievance redressal mechanism.*

(a) A Grievance Redressal Committee shall be constituted consisting of the Director of Transport as the Chairperson and two Additional Directors of Department of Transport as members.

(b) The committee shall address complaints related to licensing, Fare disputes, driver grievances, and compliance issues.

(c) Aggregators shall be required to set up a grievance redressal system on their platforms and resolve the complaints within 48 hours.

8. *Enforcement and penalties.*

(a) The Transport Department shall oversee the implementation of these Guidelines through regular audits and inspections.

- (b) Aggregators shall be required to submit annual compliance reports to the Transport Department, in Form-V as appended to these Guidelines, before thirty (30) working days after the end of the year.
- (c) Unlicensed operations or violation of licence conditions shall result in a penalty of Fifty Lakh Rupees (INR 50,00,000) and blacklisting of the person or Aggregator.
- (d) Violation of Fare regulations may result in a penalty of Five Lakh Rupees (INR 5,00,000) per instance.
