Market Consultation Brief

<u>Institutional Strengthening of Skills Employment Entrepreneurship and Innovation</u> <u>Department, Maharashtra</u>

1. Project Overview:

The Government of Maharashtra (GoM), through its Skills, Employment, Entrepreneurship, and Innovation Department (SEEID), seeks to enhance the institutional capacity of SEEID and its constituent units (DVET, CSDEE, MSSDS, MSInS, MSSU) to effectively deliver skills development, employment, entrepreneurship, and innovation programs. This market consultation aims to identify qualified firms capable of conducting a comprehensive institutional assessment and developing a time-bound action plan for SEEID's strengthening. The assessment will cover functions, funding, and functionaries (the "3Fs"), encompassing structural analysis, role mapping, workforce distribution, workload analysis, skills and competency assessment, training needs assessment, process and workflow analysis, technological infrastructure assessment, and stakeholder engagement. The final deliverable will be a detailed report with recommendations and an action plan for institutional capacity enhancement.

2. Objectives of Market Consultation:

This market consultation seeks to:

- Identify potential firms with proven experience in institutional assessments, organizational development, and capacity building within the context of government agencies, particularly in skill development and employment programs.
- Gauge the market's capacity to deliver the required services within the proposed timeframe and budget (to be determined).
- Understand the range of methodologies and approaches proposed by different firms.
- Evaluate the firms' understanding of the specific challenges faced by SEEID and its constituent units as outlined in the section on the 'Scope of Work'.
- Gather information on pricing models and potential value-added services.

3. Scope of Work (Preliminary):

The selected entity will be expected to conduct a comprehensive institutional assessment of SEEID, including:

- **Organizational Assessment:** Mapping structures, roles, responsibilities, and workforce distribution.
- **Human Resource Evaluation:** Workload analysis, skills and competency assessment, and training needs assessment.
- **Process and Workflow Analysis:** Identifying inefficiencies and recommending improvements.
- **Technological Infrastructure Assessment:** Evaluating existing systems and identifying opportunities for enhancement.
- Stakeholder Engagement: Gathering insights from internal and external stakeholders.
- **Development of an Action Plan:** Prioritizing institutional capability enhancement initiatives.

This brief provides a preliminary overview. The final Terms of Reference (ToR) will be developed post market feedback and expertise.

4. Key Areas of Expertise Required:

- Demonstrated experience in conducting similar institutional assessments within government agencies, preferably in the skill development sector.
- Expertise in organizational development, change management, and capacity building.
- Strong understanding of the Indian context and government processes.
- Proven ability to manage complex projects and deliver high-quality reports within tight deadlines.
- Team with relevant expertise (e.g., institutional expert, change management specialist).

5. Next Steps:

Firms that express interest may be invited to a short presentation and Q&A session (30-45 min) with the Government of Maharashtra, wherein they will be expected to share the following:

- Firm profile and relevant experience.
- Possible approach(es) for conducting the review and developing recommendations.
- Possible approach(es) to staffing and costing

The firms are not required to and MUST NOT share technical and financial proposals.
